This summer and fall, there were four events held to promote the VIP@work project and its results. These events took place in Romania, The Netherlands, Ireland and Italy. All were successful and impactful! Below you can find out about each event.

The Netherlands



The VIP@work event that was held in The Netherlands was a success! All project target groups and stakeholders were represented. Together with Friesland College, Inqubator hosted the event to enlighten all attendants about the VIP@work results and how they can be of a great contribution when hiring an intern. During the event, the owners of Dyseno, a marketing SME which has a team of no more than five and which hires interns for a couple of years now, have told about how beneficial it is to hire interns. While evaluating at the end, the SMEs indicated to seriously think about hiring an intern!

Romania



The event in Romania was a very fruitful one, as there was interest of 50 persons who have attended this event. The event consisted of various engaging elements: plenary session, Skype intervention and interactive workshops. This all has resulted in VIP@work stakeholders willing to collaborate in order to implement internships in the North-East Region of Romania.
